5	corporal punishment	punishment applied to the body of an offender including the death penalty, whipping, and imprisonment
6	primary resource	a document or physical object which was written or created during the time being studied
6	chattel	something (such as a slave, piece of furniture, tool, etc.) that a person owns other than land or buildings
10	abolitionist	someone who wanted to end slavery, especially in the United States before the Civil War
14	philanthropist	a wealthy person who gives money and time to help make life better for other people
19	oral history	Historical information, usually tape-recorded or videotaped, obtained in interviews with persons having firsthand knowledge.
21	commute	travel back and forth regularly, as between a place of work and home
24	advocate	to speak or write in support of a cause
25	legacy	Something handed down from the past
26	National Register of Historic Places	official list of the Nation's historic places worthy of preservation
27	preserve	to keep something in its original state or in good condition
29	impact	a strong effect
